Arts and Sciences program in Education is designed for persons who plan to transfer to a four-year college or university to complete a baccalaureate degree program that leads to teacher certification.

Modern education demands that its teachers and staff be knowledgeable both in their teaching field and in general education. Thus, this curriculum requires courses in the humanities, natural sciences, mathematics, social sciences, and health and physical education. Students are urged to acquaint themselves with the requirements of the major department of the college or university to which transfer is contemplated and to consult with the counseling center in planning their program and selecting electives.

In addition to the admission requirements established for the College, entry into the Education program requires the satisfactory completion of high school units or the equivalent including four years of English and three years of mathematics (Algebra I, Algebra II, and Geometry), 1 year of laboratory science, and 1 year of social science. Students are urged to check the mathematics requirements of the four-year college or university to which they plan to transfer to determine the proper mathematics courses to be taken in the community college.
